

Tutoring Services Summary

Aspire serves 1st - 12th grade students in Reading, Writing, and Math. During enrollment, we ask parents to bring in their child's most recent report card, test scores and/or work samples from school. We use this information as well as feedback from you and your child about school performance and experiences to plan a learning agenda that meets your child's specific needs.

Each tutoring session at Aspire is planned according to curriculum standards of the Texas Education Agency. Sessions are 50 minutes long with a teacher/student ratio of 1 teacher with up to 3 students, with an option for 1:1, where students receive consistent teaching, guidance, and evaluation. Students who are behind in school improve skills they need in-order-to fill gaps and to strengthen problem solving skills. Students who are ahead in school work on strengthening problem solving strategies to advance in their schools' curriculum.

Our lessons include interactive activities, computer programs, and pencil-paper work. We also allow students to bring in their homework from school if they need our help.

To allow each student to fully engage and improve in a single subject, we recommend one subject per tutoring session.
